Nigel has been actively involved in local conservation since 1998 as a warden of Hinderclay Fen. He became one of the founding members of the LOHP, serving as a trustee since 2002. He has a PhD in ecology and worked for the British Trust for Ornithology for 29 years. While at the BTO he led their Habitats Advisory Unit for six years before taking an overview position as in 1995 as Head of Projects. He has knowledge of habitat management and restoration, and the design and establishment of long-term monitoring programmes. He is an international expert in diagnosing the causes of bird population declines and working with communities to reverse these declines. He is an experienced contract and financial manager and fundraiser. He has been a regular volunteer undertaking practical habitat management work on the LOHP's sites and was Chair of LOHP for three years. He is currently LOHP's site warden for New Fen.
