Rob recently retired from the British Trust for Ornithology where he was a science director for more than 25 years. His career gave him extensive experience of how wildlife responds to land-use change and habitat management. He continues to be actively engaged in ecology and conservation both as a BTO Research Fellow and through an honorary position at the University of East Anglia. A long-term interest is with ecology – especially the effects of habitat management and the impacts of increasing deer populations. He works with conservation practitioners through application of ecological knowledge in habitat management and restoration, and development of habitat-based conservation strategies. He publishes widely, including four books and more than 100 peer-reviewed papers plus many others in the semi-popular and advisory literature.
