Back in June we were visited by Oak Class from Hopton Primary School. The group of 21 year 3/4 pupils (aged 7-9), enjoyed the morning learning more about their local river. They heard where the water in the Little Ouse flowed to and what had made it so silty. They saw the cattle grazing the surrounding fenland and watched the brightly coloured Banded Demoiselle Damselflies flitting about the river. They enjoyed looking at the river bugs that had been caught, from Snails to Damselfly larvae, Cased Caddis and even some small Fish.



After the event LOHP received thank-you cards and drawings from the class. Their teacher Mrs Jones said, '*The children really enjoyed their morning and have not stopped talking about it, thank you to LOHP and their volunteers for making it happen*'
